***Section 4 (1) b (viii)***

The Governing Council, Housing Committee and Mess Committee are the three bodies in the Akademi having more than two or more members.

The meeting of the Governing Council is held twice in a year under normal circumstances and the frequency might increase in case any such need arises. The Governing Council is the supreme body that outlines the functioning of IGRUA. Issues on which resolutions are passed by the Council are apprised to the respective section of public. Decisions of Council concerning amendment in selection procedures, fee structure, courses conducted in IGRUA, reservation policy, etc. are duly updated in IGRUA website. Similarly, decisions concerning employees and/or any section of staff members are duly promulgated amongst employees by display on Notice Boards. Apart from this, minutes of Governing Council Meetings are available in IGRUA Library for reference.

The Housing Committee is an internal body constituted to make recommendations for formulating/amending/repealing rules of allotment of residences, allotment of vacant residences, etc. Decisions taken in the Housing Committee Meetings are displayed on Notice Board.

Mess Committee is constituted for the purpose of providing quality messing facilities and ensuring proper upkeep of students' hostels. The Mess Committee's decisions commensurate with the requirements of all beneficiaries in general and the flying cadets in particular. The decisions of Mess Committee are displayed on the Notice board, and any suggestions for improving the services are welcomed.
